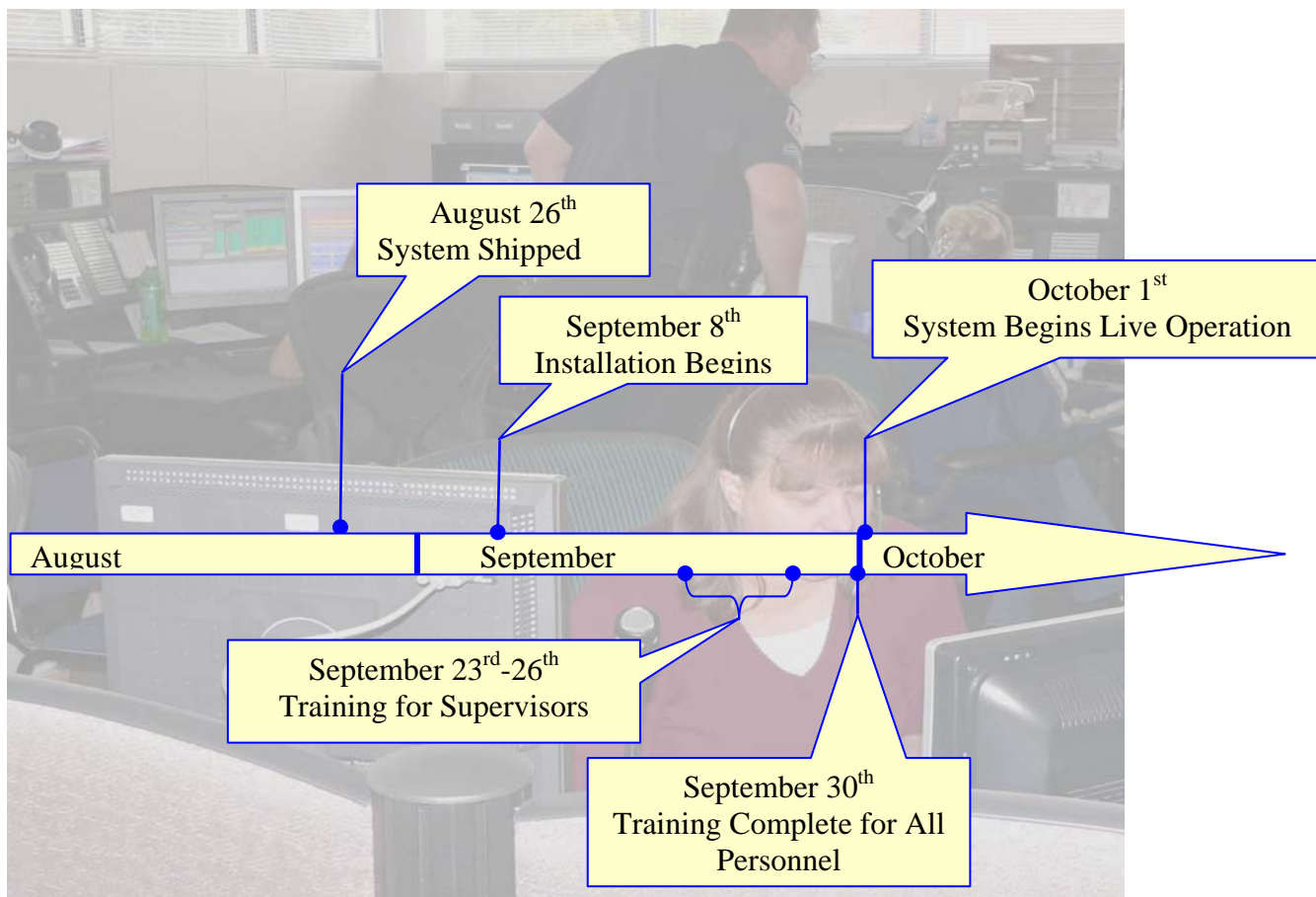


Support Services Division August 2008

A team from the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies conducted an on-site assessment of the department this month for the purpose of certifying that we are in compliance with all applicable standards. A large portion of the mandatory standards apply directly to functions of the Support Services Division such as communications, booking, evidence, crime prevention, training, etc. The assessment team was very thorough and although we will not know the outcome for some time, the comments from the team were very positive. One of the assessors commented that our department “lived the process” indicating that we actually operate within our written policies daily not just at assessment time. This is a very high compliment for our department coming from a CALEA official.
