Call to Order.

Chairman Josh Hayes call the meeting to order at 4:01 pm.

ITEM #1 – REVIEW TEST

Chairman Hayes started the meeting discussing the changing of the plumbing test. The master commercial drawing includes a kitchen. Does the board like to change the drawing or leave it the way it is? The board members went back and forth on suggestions, like removing the drawing and making something else on the test worth more, leaving the drawing on the test but ask the question what is not up to code for Missouri on the drawing. Garbage Disposals are no longer allowed in commercial kitchens as grease interceptors are required in its place. Next it was discussed if scoring should stay the same or should separate out by questions and practical. Also, would like the Master to be able to pass the questions by 75% and journeyman pass by 70%. Scott Helsel, Plumbing Inspector brought up the ideal of change how the test is administered. We have an outside agency that would administer the written test at no cost to the City. If the person passes the written section than they would meet with the board and do the practical section of the test. The test questions have been reviewed and they all are based on the 2018 IPC Code. Wondered if some of the City policies should also be included, but then a handout would be required as no one from outside the City would know those policies. The board agreed to ponder these ideas and meet again on November 12, 2020 at 4 pm to discuss them further.

ITEM #2 – ROBERT MILLER

It was decided he would take the test in January 2021. So, he filled out paperwork and will be on the schedule for the next test.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:47 pm, by Chairman Hayes and 2nd by Brian Weets.
