**ITEM #3 Discussion on community concerns**

Charles Hayes asked about the departments training related to current events. The Chief discussed our implicit bias training, de-escalation, mental health first aid, and Crisis Intervention Training. All of which we have done for years, long before the current events driven narrative. Eric Harris brought up concerns about homeless individuals aggressively pan handling, and people walking through neighborhoods and stealing. Dennis Adams also spoke of aggressive pan handling near his business. Captain Olszowka spoke about these issues and the involved parties.

**ITEM #4 Interaction with Police Department**

Chief Connally discussed recommendations received from the Blue Ribbon committee. Chief Connally also updated the committee on recent community engagements including national night out, midtown youth breakfast, and the upcoming FOP sponsored Christmas with Cops. Chief Connally then discussed crime trends with the committee, overall crime is down with the exception of aggravated assault which was up 1.5%. The committee was also introduce to Kristin Siler-Kline our

Community Mental Health Liaison. She explained her job and how she has integrated into the department. Captain Olszowka discussed efforts to address recent catalytic converter thefts and burglaries of vacant buildings.


