# 2021 Rabies Vaccination Clinics

All dogs and cats over 3 months of age are required to be vaccinated against rabies and registered with the city.

<b>Rabies Vaccination:</b>	\$ 5 per animal
<b>Registration Tags:</b>	\$15 per unaltered animals \$ 5 per altered (spay/neuter*) animals <i>*MUST have written proof of sterilization</i>
<b>Microchip:</b>	\$10 (Optional)
<b>Dog Park Tag:</b>	\$ 5 (Optional)
<b>Combination Vaccination:</b>	\$10 (Optional - Payable to the veterinarian, cash only)

Pets **MUST** be under adult supervision. Dogs **MUST** be leashed and cats **MUST** be in a carrier.
